The story of an African prince sold into slavery and his connection to one of the largest companies involved in the slave trade at the time, the Royal African Company, who shipped cloth, guns and alcohol to West Africa in exchange for enslaved Africans who were then transported to Barbados and Jamaica. The Company shipped more enslaved Africans than any other English organisation during the entire period of that trade – nearly 150,000 people
