General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2018 Consent Form

Lists of just the names and contact details, may be shared with serving committee members/role holders to facilitate contact, (e.g. Friends in Need). The information we hold is never shared with anyone outside Hadara.

You have the right to see the information we hold, to amend it or to withdraw it. If you cease to be a member, we cease to process the data. You have the right to be forgotten and all of your data can be completely erased, if you request it.

If you wish to see or change the personal data that we hold about you, please apply in writing to the Membership Secretary, address given below, who will provide the information to you, within 30 days.

As a member of a social association you should have a reasonable expectation that photographs will be taken at many Hadara events and activities. Any photographs taken may appear in the Hadara Diary, Hadara Noticeboard, Hadara Website or in a Kentara publication, without further consent being requested.
