Day 1, Wednesday: Kent to County Durham

Depart local pick-up points and commence journey northwards. With suitable comfort stops en route we aim to arrive at our hotel in the late afternoon with time to relax before dinner.

Day 2, Thursday, Durham/Bishop Auckland

Depart hotel and travel to the beautiful city of **Durham**, with its magnificent Norman cathedral and ancient links to the Viking invasions and the Monks of Lindisfarne. There will be ample time to explore the upper quarter of the town, take a cruise on the river, or visit National Trust's Crook Gardens in the lower town. Return via the restored town of **Bishop Auckland**, dominated by Auckland Castle, once seat of the powerful Prince Bishops of Durham. Entrance fee applies for Castle

Day 3: Beamish Open Air Museum & Saltburn by the Sea

Morning visit to the **Beamish Open Air Museum** where we discover the way of life in the North East of England in Georgian, Victorian and Edwardian times. In the afternoon we will visit the charming Victorian seaside town of **Saltburn by the Sea** before returning to our hotel.

Day 4: Barnard Castle/Kynren show

This morning we visit **Barnard Castle** before returning to our hotel for a late lunch at 2pm, after which we have time to change for the evening, and the action packed **Kynren Show** – a 90 minute live outdoor show performed by a dedicated cast of over 1000 volunteers. The breathtaking performance takes audiences on a stunning, award-winning journey through 2000 years of English history bringing to life the stories of King Arthur and other important people and events in our great history

Day 5: County Durham to Kent

Depart hotel after breakfast and travel homewards to Kent. With comfort stops en route we aim to arrive back at pick up points in the early evening.
