BLenheim PALACE



Blenheim Palace, located in Woodstock, Oxfordshire, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the only non-royal country house in England to hold the title of palace. Built between 1705 and 1722, it is a prime example of English Baroque architecture and the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill.

We will leave Hartley around 9.00am to arrive at the Palace in good time to visit most of the attractions within the Palace and outside in the gardens.

There are cafes and a restaurant, or you may wish to take a packed lunch
